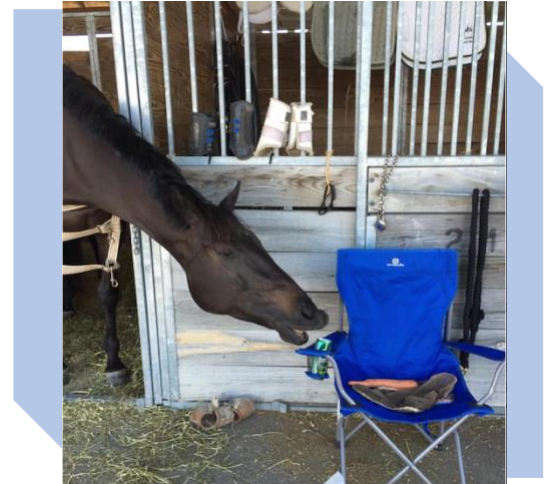
important information

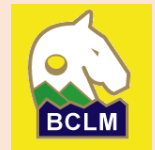
Plant those watermelons.
